CNP has to arrange for transportation of Iron Scrap of condemned printing machines from Currency Note Press, Nashik Road to Alloy Steel Plant (SAIL), Nirman Bhawan, Durgapur (West Bengal) Pin -713208 by Road in open top containers.

Total approximate weight of Iron Scrap will be 465 MT.

Scope of work (Job Specification):-

1. Transportation of Iron Scrap from Currency Note Press, Nashik Road to Alloy Steel Plant, Durgapur (West Bengal) in open top container/truck in one side trip only.
2. Transporter will co-ordinate with authorized CNP representative for deployment/loading of container.
3. Locking: The container will be locked by CNP representative after loading the container and keys will be handed over to accompanying officer deputed by Currency Note Press and sealed cover handed over to the Alloy Steel Plant, representative at Durgapur.
4. Strictly Confidential: The details of goods and particular and movement of container shall be kept confidential by transporter and shall be known only to consignee.
5. Transporter in co-ordination with CNP representative and CISF and shall arrange movement in such a manner that consignment shall not be required to be detained for unloading en-route to Durgapur. Goods to be transported being important and proper care should be taken while handling and transportation to avoid tampering of containers, any pilferage, damage etc.
6. Carrier Risk: The consignment will be insured by CNP under Insurance policy. Transporter should strictly adhere to fulfil the obligation as per insurance norms. Any claim referred by Insurance Company on account of negligence of transporter will solely be borne by the transporter.



7. Transporter shall quote for transportation charges per MT including all other incidental charges, detention charges, other fees etc.

8. Transporter shall ensure proper closure of doors of the containers after loading before starting journey.

9. In case of an accident in transit or for any other reason, if a container needs to be transshipped on to another container en-route, the transshipment shall be carried out by the transporter at his cost and risk. The contractor shall also be liable to pay the compensation/claims arising out of any damage to container and cargo including the claims in respect of short deliveries if any occurring due to such mishaps. The contractor is advised to take appropriate insurance coverage with CNP against such unforeseen events.

10. In case of long lead road transportation events like imposition of restriction on movement by State Government authorities on a particular route or in certain timings or diversion of routes on temporary basis due to civil works, law and order situation, festivals etc shall not form the basis for claiming higher rates.

11. Drivers of vehicles should have valid license for heavy motor vehicle, identity proof. He should produce the same if asked.

12. Transporter shall ensure that only vehicle in very good running condition are deployed for this purpose and crew with vehicle shall be skilled and of credentials deemed fit for accompanying consignment. Also valid documents required such as RC Book, PUC, Fitness Certificate, Insurance etc should be available with the vehicle deployed for the job.

13. Escort: CISF escort will be deployed /provided by Currency Note Press from Nashik to Durgapur.
