1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

A) SPECIFICATIONS & GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

Unloading & Shifting of 07 nos of Machine Boxes/Cases to desired section of CNP, Nashik.

GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

1. Unloading and Shifting of Various new m/c's cases reg. from the truck/ containers/ closed containers/ trailers using suitable crane, hydra, forklift, slings on minimum 12mm MS/suitable plates etc. at location at CNP.
2. Heavy cases are required to be unloaded and shifted to the respective foundation as communicated by CNP at CNP without any damage to CNP property
3. All the required unloading and shifting tools along with MS plates to be arranged by the firm.
4. The machine cases and its auxiliaries may be unloaded at two or three different stations at CNP. Then at a suitable time as communicated the cases to be opened and shifted to the respective foundations. The packing materials to be shifted to CNP-IV scrap yard.(Packing material wt. = Gross.Wt.- Net Wt.)
5. The firm representatives should visit the site to ascertain required tools, tackles and manpower required for unloading of the cases, check the route of travel and sort out the necessary queries before quoting / commit to fulfill subsequent requirements for the above specified job work execution on turnkey basis.
6. The contractor needs to have close coordination and interaction with the concerned officials for effective time management, safe unloading of the sophisticated machines, smoothly to the location suggested by the concerned officials at CNP.
7. Contractor shall employ required no. of trained & skilled operator and helpers to carry out the complete job work under the close supervision of his project manager.
8. CNP will intimate the firm probable date of arrival of shipment at CNP, Nashik. The unloading work has to be started immediately after the truck /containers/closed containers/trailers arrive at CNP, Nashik Road, site to avoid demurrage charges. If the firm fails to arrange required tools , tackles and manpower required for unloading within 12 Hrs. after arrival of shipment at CNP the demurrage charges if any incurred for this period will be recovered from the firm.
9. In case of unavoidable circumstances/natural calamity, if the cases are required to be shifted to safe place as suggested by CNP authority and again shifting to the respective foundation is in the scope of the firm without any additional cost to CNP.
10. The required material handling equipment's, suitable tools & tackles in commensurate with the requirement of the job needs to have proper documents and to be mobilized well in advance to the actual place of the work.
11. All the boxes are to be unloaded, to the place suggested at CNP. However best efforts to be made to complete the work within minimum possible time.
12. Time is very important factor to complete the entire work, failing to the above time line will attract LD charges.
13. Standard safety procedures need to be followed in order to ensure safety of both personnel and material. The contractor is fully responsible for the safety and security of their persons working in CNP. In no means CNP will be held responsible or compensate in any case of any mishap to the persons working under the contractor.
14. Contractor should make payment as per prevailing minimum wages rule, labour laws etc.

15. Contractor need to take workmen compensation insurance policy for the above work and a copy of the policy needs to be submitted to the CNP before starting the work.

16. In case of damage to the property of CNP Nashik, due to mis operation/ mishandling of any of the equipment, CNP shall not be liable for any damage and contractor needs to compensate as decided by CNP Nashik.

17. The quoted price shall be fixed, firm & binding and valid for 12 months from the date of price bid of tender and no escalation in price on any account shall be admissible during the contract period. The price shall be inclusive of all the taxes, manpower, equipment's insurance, mobilization and demobilization duties, levies, etc.

18. Statutory deductions shall be made at source as per prevailing rules.

19. The completion period of job work will be 01 year (one year) from the date of purchase order.

20. The firm should quote the job work of unloading and shifting of cases/boxes on Tonnage basis. Payment to the firm will be released according to the completion of complete job work of unloading of cases/boxes as per scope of work.

B) TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND SAFETY CODES TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE CONTACTORS/THEIR EMPLOYEES.

1. The principal firm to whom the job work has been assigned will be primarily responsible to ensure the safety of all their employees working under them while they work inside factory premises.

2. The principal firm to whom the job work has been assigned will be responsible for any act of the contractors, which amounts to contravention of any provision of the Factory Act, 1948 and the Maharashtra factory act, 1963.

3. The principal firm to whom the job work has been assigned will ensure and monitor the following:-

3.1 The firm has to nominate one of the competent supervisors, who in addition to his duty will also be responsible to look after the safety of employees working under them and safety of nearby other plant equipment. The name, address and mobile number should be informed to the safety department CNP before commencement of works. The principal firm will have to submit date wise detail work schedule/work plan in prescribed format to the safety department at least three days in advance before the start of the work. This is very essential so as to identify the risks and for job safety analysis.

3.2 Contractor will provide personal protective equipment's to his employees to ensure their safety.

3.3 Electrical connection will be taken only with the written permission from the electrical department CNP.

3.4 Contractor will ensure that their employees do not smoke inside the factory premises.

3.5 Contractor will ensure that the hand tools, power tools, forklifts, Hydra, ladders, slings and equipment's etc. are maintained in good working condition and will also ensure that they are safe and free from risk to employees.

3.6 All the machines brought by contractor for their job work should be properly guarded/ maintained in proper condition for their safe working.

3.7 For working at height, welding work, gas cutting work, excavation work, working on fragile roof, working on electrical line or work of similar nature. The principal firm and their contractor will inform the safety dept. CNP in advance and in each case the "Permit to work" will be obtained from safety dept.

3.8 All the lifting M/c's, lifting tackles, chain ropes, pulleys etc. will not be allowed in factory premises unless they are thoroughly examined and certified by the competent person (as per Factory act 1948) once in every six month. Such certificate should be produced to CNP before taking them inside the factory.

3.9 In case of any accident, the firm representative will arrange to inform it to the safety dept. CNP immediately. The agency will also arrange to inform The inspector of Factories Nashik

C) MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Experience & Past Performance:

The bidder should have experience of having successfully completed similar kind of services for the value at least 435 MT of quantity in any one of the last five years ending on March-2023.

2. Capability: The bidder must have Annual Capacity and Capability to provide this works for 435 MT of quantity.

3. Financial Standing:

i) The average annual turnover of the bidder during the last three financial years i.e. 2020-2021, 2021-2022 & 2022-2023 should be more than Rs.10,34,500/- .

Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
