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Section VII: Technical Specification

1. Earthwork in excavation in ordinary soil/hard moorum by mechanical means/manual means in foundation trenches or drains including dressing of sides and ramming of bottoms including getting out the excavated soil. The scope of work shall also include disposal of the excess earth up to a distance of 1 Km. The quoted rate shall include cost of machinery/labour, hire charges for vehicle, equipment, tools & tackles etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 100.00 m3).
2. Backfilling available excavated earth (excluding rock) in trenches, plinth, sides of foundations etc. in layers not exceeding 20 cm in depth, consolidating each deposited layer by ramming and watering. The quoted rate shall include cost of all labour, equipment, hire charges for vehicle, tools & tackles etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 100.00 m3).
3. Providing and laying in position cement concrete 1:2:4 with 20 mm nominal size stone aggregate excluding the cost of centering and shuttering including all work upto plinth level. The quoted rate shall include cost of all materials, labour, transportation to work site, equipment, tools & tackles etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 15.00 m3).
4. Constructing brick masonry manhole in cement mortar 1:4 with RCC top slab with cement concrete 1:2:4 (20mm nominal size stone aggregate), foundation concrete 1:4:8 100 mm thick, inside cement plaster 12 mm thick with cement mortar 1:3 finished with a floating coat of neat cement and making channels in cement concrete 1:2:4 finished with a floating coat of neat cement. The manhole shall be of size 1.20 m x 0.90 m and 0.90 m deep with C.I. cover and frame (Heavy duty) 560 mm internal diameter, total weight of cover and frame to be not less than 208 kg (weight of cover 108 kg and weight of frame 100 kg). The quoted rate shall include cost of all materials, labour, transportation to work site, tools & tackles etc. complete. (Manhole shall be constructed with common burnt clay FPS (non-modular) bricks of class designation 7.5) (Estimated Qty. 7.00 EA).
5. Extra for depth for manholes of size 1.20 m x 0.90 m beyond 0.90 m depth with common burnt clay FPS (non-modular) bricks of class designation 7.5 (Estimated Qty. 7.00 m).
6. Providing and laying non pressure NP2 class (light duty) RCC pipes of diameter 150 mm with collars jointed with stiff mixture of cement mortar in the proportion of 1:2 including testing of joints. The quoted rate shall include cost of all materials, labour, transportation to work site, tools & tackles etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 18.00 m).



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7. Dismantling of Cement Concrete of grade M-15 by mechanical means/manual means including disposal of debris to a distance up to 1 Km. The quoted rate shall include cost of all labour, equipment, hire charges for vehicle, tools & tackles etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 15.00 m³).

8. Cleaning & De-sludging of Sewer Line of pipe diameter from 150 mm to 300 mm including removing all accumulated deposits, loose grits/sand etc. The scope of work shall also include checking/testing of sewer line for flow after cleaning/de-sludging and disposal of debris to a distance up to 1 Km. The rate shall include cost of labour, equipments, tools & tackles, hire charges for vehicle, checking/testing of flow etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 1500.00 m).

9. Cleaning of manholes of depth up to 2.50 m by pumping out sludge water and effluents etc. including removal of all loose sediment /sand/sludge/mud etc including disposal of debris up to a distance of 1 Km. The scope of work shall also include checking/testing of manholes for flow after cleaning. The quoted rate shall include cost of labour, equipments, tools & tackles, checking/testing of flow etc. complete. (Estimated Qty. 150.00 EA).

10. Dismantling old rectangular manhole of size 120 x 90 cm and depth up to 2.50 m including RCC top slab, CI cover with frame including stacking of usefull materials and disposal of unserviceable materials up to a distance of 1 Km. (Estimated Qty. 7.00 EA) 11. Constructing brick masonry road gully chamber 50 x 45 x 60 cm with common burnt clay FPS (non-modular) bricks of class designation 7.5 in cement mortar 1:4 including 500 x 450 mm precast RCC horizontal grating with frame. Technical specifications of materials to be used:

1. Cement: Cement shall be OPC 43 grade. Approved make: Ultratech/ACC/Orient/Birla Super/Birla Gold.
2. Sand shall be preferably river sand and in case of non-availability/other statutory conditions M-sand/Artificial sand shall be used. Sand shall be fine and grain size shall be less than 4.75 mm.
3. Stone aggregate: 20 mm down stone aggregate shall be used for Cement concrete.
4. Bricks: Common burnt clay FPS (non-modular) bricks of class designation. 7.5 shall be used for manhole construction and shall be of size 230 mm x 100 mm x 75 mm. (Tolerance in size: +/- 0.50 inch).



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Terms and Conditions

1. Quantity Variation: The above quantities are approximate only. The actual quantities may vary (up to +/- 5%) depending upon site requirement while execution of work. Payment will be made as per actual work done quantity only.
2. This contract is of Annual Maintenance nature and therefore, the work shall be executed as & when required. Hence, it may not be necessary that the full quantities of all the items will be exhausted.
3. This contract is for One Year Period.
4. The payment will be made quarterly on the basis of joint measurement for the work executed in that quarter.
5. The firm shall take necessary safety precautions while carrying out the work. Total responsibility of Contractor persons will lie on the contractor & not on C.N.P.
6. The firm shall provide PPE to their workmen while working at site.
7. Firm shall clean the site before handing over to C.N.P.
8. The firm shall test the drainage line and manhole for flow after providing new drainage line and construction of new manhole as the case may be.
9. The firm shall test the drainage line and manhole for flow after cleaning of existing drainage line and cleaning of existing manhole as the case may be.
10. The firm shall dispose all the waste, malba, surplus excavated earth, sludge etc. up to a distance of 1 Km and the vehicle for the disposal of the same shall be arranged by the firm.
11. The vehicle arranged by agency for disposing all waste must have all necessary statutory requirements completed & valid driver's license.
12. The total job work is on turnkey basis. The contractor shall arrange for required materials, labour, equipment, vehicles, tools & tackles etc.
13. The working time shall be 8.00 am to 5.00 pm including lunch hour on Working days only.
14. Electricity required will be provided by C.N.P. at site but the Responsibility of safe use of electricity will be on contractor not on C.N.P.



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15. The firm shall take extra care for electrical cables, telephone/SAP cables while excavation.

16. The firm shall complete the drainage section coming under road as soon as possible to avoid inconvenience to inside traffic.

 - (b) For other firm - Experience and past performance:
The bidder should have experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending on 31.03.2023
 - a. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 8,07,000/- or
 - b. Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 10,09,000/- or
 - c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 16,14,000/-.
