Introduction:

The Currency Note Press (CNP) in Nashik invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from reputed and experienced firms for the construction of a state-of-the-art Currency & Security Product Museum. This ambitious project aims to create a modern facility that will showcase the history, technology, and artistry of currency and security products. The museum will serve as a premier destination for visitors to learn about the evolution of these products and the role they play in society.

Project Overview:

The proposed museum will encompass architectural design, construction work (including civil and electrical work), exhibition curation, provision of security systems, display planning of artifacts, and the setup of educational facilities. The museum will be designed to offer a comprehensive educational experience, blending traditional exhibits with interactive and multimedia elements.

Detailed Scope of Work:

1. Architectural Design:

Conceptual Design: Develop an innovative and comprehensive conceptual design that reflects the theme and purpose of the museum. The design should consider visitor flow, accessibility, and sustainability.

Detailed Design: Prepare detailed architectural plans, including floor plans, elevations, sections, and construction specifications. This should also include structural, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing (MEP) designs.

Interior Design: Develop interior design concepts for exhibition halls, educational facilities, administrative areas, and visitor amenities. This includes selecting materials, finishes, furniture, and fixtures.

Landscaping: Design the external landscaping to enhance the aesthetic appeal of the museum. This includes pathways, gardens, water features, and outdoor exhibit spaces, etc.

2. Construction Work:

Site Preparation: Conduct site surveys and soil testing, and prepare the site for construction, including clearing, grading, and drainage.

Civil Work: Execute all necessary civil works including excavation, foundation laying, structural work (columns, beams, slabs), masonry, plastering, and finishing.

Electrical Work: Install comprehensive electrical systems including power distribution, lighting (both general and exhibit-specific), emergency lighting, and backup power systems (generators, UPS).

HVAC Systems: Install heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems to ensure a comfortable environment for visitors and staff. This includes climate control for sensitive artifacts.

Plumbing and Sanitation: Complete all necessary plumbing and sanitation work, including water supply, drainage, and installation of restrooms, etc.

3. Exhibition Curation:

Content Development: Research and develop engaging and educational content for the exhibits. This should cover the history, technology, and security features of currency and security products.

Exhibit Design: Design interactive and engaging exhibits that utilize multimedia (audio, video, interactive displays), artifacts, replicas, and digital installations.

Installation: Oversee the installation of all exhibits, ensuring they are securely and aesthetically placed. This includes mounting, lighting, and configuring interactive elements.

4. Security Systems:

CCTV Systems: Install a state-of-the-art CCTV system for comprehensive surveillance and security of the museum premises. This includes high-resolution cameras, monitoring stations, and data storage solutions.

Fire Safety Systems: Implement advanced fire detection and suppression systems to safeguard the building and its contents. This includes smoke detectors, fire alarms, sprinkler systems, and fire extinguishers.

Access Control: Establish access control measures to restrict entry to sensitive areas. This includes electronic locks, ID card access systems, and visitor management systems.

5. Display Planning of Artifacts:

6. Educational Facilities:

Learning Spaces: Set up auditorium equipped with modern audio-visual aids for educational programs, lectures, and workshops.

Resource Center: Develop a resource center with a library, archives, and digital resources for researchers, students, and enthusiasts. This should include workstations, reading areas, and digital access points.

11. Important Instructions to Bidders for submission of the documents:

- i. The participating firms shall be required to submit all related technical details, capabilities of the firm, product catalogues, and specifications of the proposed system, technical write up and presentation(if necessary) on the proposed museum.
- ii. The interested parties can visit CNP to see area to be covered & assess the requirement before submission of bids.
- iii. The interested & experienced firms should also be required to submit along with Expression of Interest, a list of customers for whom a similar project is executed with details and performance report from their clients.
- iv. The participating firm shall have carried out the similar project in last 3 years. The firm shall provide Purchase Order copies of the customers for whom a similar project is executed in the past 03 years with details of the work and their addresses along with phone, fax and email addresses and performance report from them.
- v. The Participating firms should give a declaration that they have not been blacklisted or debarred for dealing by Government of India or any Government in the past.
- vi. The documents in support of Expression of Interest need to be submitted duly signed by the authorized representative of the applicant with name and designation of the signatory.
- vii. The documents in support of Expression of Interest (viz. Supply order details/ Installation Certificates/ Addresses of customers and their contact numbers) need to be submitted duly signed by authorized representative of the applicant.
- viii. Please fill and submit the format provided at Annexure – “A” along with this document.

ix. The principal firm will have to directly participate in this EOI. Participation of any authorized firm by any principal bidder will not be considered.

x. Bidders are requested to submit Budgetary Quotations for the project along with payment terms.

12. Procurement Process:

Following are the details of this procurement process:

- i. At first, the Expression of Interest is being floated for above mentioned work.
- ii. The firms intending to participate in the EOI have to present a detailed presentation at CNP, Nashik regarding their offers of the work and the cost for such visits shall be borne by firms only.
- iii. After evaluation of the responses received, a Tender will be floated in cooperating all the terms and conditions, specification as per buyer's requirement. An Open tender will be floated for active participation of bidders.

13. The Bid shall be submitted in English Language only. The Authenticated copies of the documents in support or applicant's claim may be submitted in English Language.

14. The bidders will be required to give a presentation on mutually agreed date after submission of the offer.

15. The bidders shall provide copies of balance sheet, Profit & Loss statement, of last Five years ending March-2024. If Financial Year maintaining calendar year wise then up to December-2023. All the Financial data to be certified by Charter Accountant in India and certified by Public Accountant in foreign as the case may be.

16. The bidders shall enclose details of quality accreditations received by them.

17. The dully filled details along with supporting documents should be sent in a sealed envelope super scribing "Expression of Interest for Hiring of Architect Cum Consultant Firm for Construction of State-of-the-art Currency & Security Product Museum".
