This Bid provides for Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) as Preferred mode of payment. For MSME sellers, payments may be processed through a TReDS exchange in which the Buyer is registered, subject to applicable policy and regulatory guidelines. Accordingly, sellers intending to avail payment through TReDS are required to be registered with at least one TReDS exchange in which the buyer is registered.

1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.
[OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017 and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry .Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller/service provider is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

7. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

I) TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION & SCOPE OF WORK: ATTACHED ANNEXURE-I IN BUYER ADDED BID SPECIFIC ATC

II) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Supply, Installation and Commissioning of CNC Lathe Machine at CNP Nashik

1. Experience and past performance :

The bidder (Manufacturer or principal of authorized representative- hereinafter referred simply as 'The Bidder') shall be a manufacturer that has regularly for at least the last three year manufactured, supplied, erected, commissioned CNC Lathe with the same or higher specification of at least one number in last five years ending on 31.03.2026. At least one number of the product offered for supply should be in successful operation for at least one year on the date of bid opening.

2. Capability, Equipment & Manufacturing Facilities:

The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 01 Nos. of CNC Lathe of similar or higher capacity.

3. Financial Standing:

(a) The average annual financial turnover of the bidder firm (manufacturer or principal of authorized dealer) during the last three years, ending on 31st March 2026, should be more than Rs.32,77,450/- as per the annual report (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account) of the relevant period duly authenticated by a chartered accountant/Cost accountant in India.

(b) The Net Worth of the firm should :

i) Not be negative on 31st March 2026 and

ii) Not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three financial years ending on 31.03.2026.

Note :

- i. Copies of PO's and Completion /Experience certificates along with detailed scope of work issued by customers to be provided in support of above.
- ii. Start-ups and Micro and small enterprises (registered for tendered item) are exempted from experience and past performance criteria & all financial standing. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and past performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation. However, its capacity and capability may be verified (if necessary) by the CNP, Nashik.
- iii. To ascertain this criteria net worth of initial and last financial year shall be compared.

4. Applicability in Special Cases :

a) Applicability to 'Make in India' : Bidders (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) If the product is being manufactured in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights and where there is a technology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content, and who while meeting all other criteria above, except for any or more of sub-criteria in Experience and Past Performance above, would also be considered to be qualified provided: i) their foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights, meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the Bidder submits appropriate documentary proof for technology collaboration agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content. iii) the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) furnishes along with the bid a legally enforceable undertaking jointly executed by himself and such foreign Manufacturer for satisfactory manufacture, Supply (and erection, commissioning if applicable) and performance of 'The Product' offered including all warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract.

b) Authorized Representatives: Bids of bidders quoting as authorized representative of a principal manufacturer would also be considered to be qualified, provided: i) their principal manufacturer meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a legally enforceable tender-specific authorization in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder himself should have been associated, as authorized representative of the same or other Principal Manufacturer for same set of services as in present bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissioning, after sales service as the case may be) for same or similar 'Product' for past three years ending on 'The Relevant Date'.

c) For Existing successful Past Suppliers : In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past supplier of 'The Product' in at least one of the recent past three procurements (within SPMCIL/BRBNMPL/BNPMIPL), who do not meet any or more of requirements above, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past to any units of SPMCIL. (This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)

d) Joint Ventures and Holding Companies : Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repeat cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each partner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently. However, for the purpose of

qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be clubbed with only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving such ownership.

e) Start-up Enterprises: Requirements of Experience & Past performance and Financial Standing would be relaxed for Start-up enterprises as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications. Such Start-ups may be either MSE or otherwise

III. Other requirements for the Bidders :

1. The bidder has to submit Power of Attorney/ Authorization indicating that authorized signatory is competent and legally authorized to submit the tender and /or enter into legally binding contract.

2. Manufacturer's Authorization Letter (Annexure-II): The firm has to submit Manufacturer's Authorization Certificate for CNC Lathe at the time of technical bid.

a) Wherever authorized firm are submitting the bid, Manufacture Authorization Form/Certificate with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.

b) The bidder shall submit the manufacturer's authorization letter to this effect as per the standard form provided in buyer uploaded ATC Uploaded document.

3. PAN and Goods & Service Tax Registration (GST) : The bidder should be registered with the Income Tax. Relevant Proof in support shall be submitted.

IV) UNDERTAKING(S) AND DECLARATION:

a) The bidder should give undertaking/declaration that they have read and understood all the terms & conditions of tender documents including GIT and GCC and submitting unconditional acceptance to all terms & conditions.

b) Undertaking of declaration that the bidder is not blacklisted/debarred for dealing by Government of India to be submitted duly sealed and signed.

c) Undertaking towards compliance of, border sharing criteria as per guidelines issued by Government of India (vide letter no.F.No.6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd/24th July 2020 or any further amendments thereof).

d) Documentary/undertaking against Make in India Status i.e., being a Class-I /Class-II supplier with details of percentage of local contents.

V) Delivery Period : 150 days for Supply, Erection, Testing & Commissioning, FAT including Levelling and Function Test of CNC Lathe as per technical specification mentioned in tender documents from the date issue of GeM Contract.

VI) Pre-Dispatch Inspections:

- i. The Pre-Dispatch Inspection (PDI) shall be done by the CNP Officials before the dispatch of materials as per mutually agreed schedule for installation at site (section wise).
- ii. If the supplier differs from materials as per previous PDI, then PDI shall be done again for the differed material.
- iii. The duration of PDI will be 02 days for the inspection of material.
- iv. All expense towards Traveling, Boarding & Lodging of CNP's Inspectors are to be borne by CNP. In case of rejection, Re-inspection (Re-PDI) may be done, if necessary, at supplier's cost.
- v. Pre-Dispatch Inspection Intimation: The supplier/manufacturer shall provide a minimum of Ten (10) working days' written notice before offering materials for inspection. Inspection shall be carried out only after receipt of such notice and confirmation from the CNP.

VII) Final Decision:

- i. The Purchaser reserves the right to carry out further inspections upon receipt of materials at site. Acceptance during PDI shall not constitute final acceptance.
- ii. The decision of the Purchaser regarding acceptance or rejection of equipment shall be final and binding with respect to compliance with contractual specifications.

VIII) Payments Terms -

100% payment will be released after successful Supply, Erection, Testing & Commissioning, FAT including Levelling and Function Test of CNC Lathe as per technical specification mentioned in tender documents with its accessories.

IX) Warranty Clause - The Warranty will remain valid for a period of minimum 12 Months from the date of successful installation, testing, commissioning & final acceptance test at site.

X) Training - 03 days training shall be given to all CNP employees working in CNC machine.

XI) Evaluation Method:

a) Total value wise evaluation: The total price quoted for all items shall be considered for evaluation after RA to decide L-1 bidder.

XII) Performance Security Deposit: 5% of order value.
